More than 40% of UUP members are contingent employees, i.e., having no path to permanency.



Roughly 1 in every 4 professionals and 3 in every 5 academics are contingent.



Professionals:



More than half of part-time, temporary professionals earn less than \$17,000 a year.



More than half of part-time, temporary professionals work half-time or greater.

Academics:



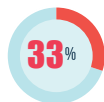
The percentage of part-time contingent faculty has increased over the last decade. Today, part-time academics comprise more than one-third of the faculty at the majority of SUNY's state-operated campuses.



Part-time academics comprise more than 50% of the faculty at several SUNY state-operated campuses.



Half of part-time academics earn less than \$275 per week.



1 in 3 part-time academics earns less than \$200 per week.



1 in 5 part-time academics earns less than \$175 per week.



SUNY is overly dependent on its part-time academics and professionals—those with the lowest pay and the least job security.
