Another year of college! How are we going to afford that?

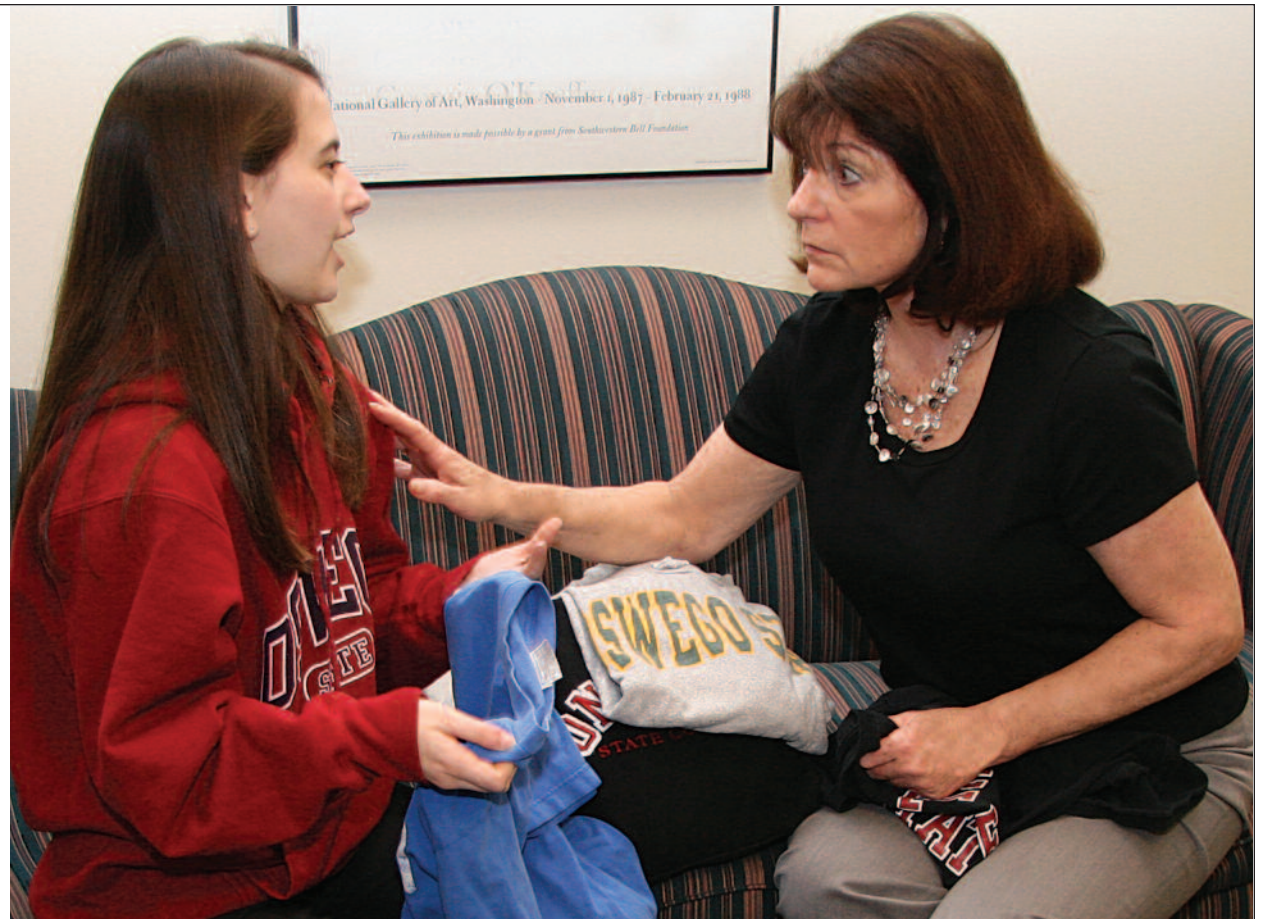
You're happy she's home for winter recess, but what she just told you about her SUNY college leaves you speechless.
