Frequently Asked Questions

Now that members have ratified the new four-year contract between UUP and New York state, what is the next step in the approval process?

The governor's office will submit a pay bill to the Legislature. Once that bill is passed by the Legislature and signed by the governor, the funds become available for the pay raises stipulated in the contract.

When do I receive my retroactive pay?

The dates for the 2007 retroactive raises have not been set. The New York State Comptroller's Office will issue a payroll bulletin when the administrative steps with SUNY and the Governor's Office of Employee Relations have been completed. UUP will continue to work with the Comptroller's Office and will alert UUPers ASAP when a check date is announced. Please continue to monitor the UUP Web site.

When will I start receiving the 2008 pay increases called for in the contract?

The pay raises take effect either July 1 or Sept. 1, depending on the date of your appointment.

How much of a raise do part-timers receive?

Part-time employees are eligible for the same across-the-board salary increases as full-timers. By the end of the contract, base salary rates will increase by at least 13.6 percent.

Will part-timers also get DSI money?

Yes, part-timers are eligible for discretionary salary increases. Decisions on raises are at the discretion of each campus.
