## Ballot Question

*"...the question 'Shall there be a convention to revise the constitution and amend the same' shall be submitted to and decided by the electors of the state..."*

***IF WE DON'T STOP IT IN NOV. 2017, THEN:*** 

## Convention

- *"The electors of every senate district of the state...shall elect three delegates at the next ensuing general election..." [Nov. 2018]*
- *"...and the electors of the state voting at the same election shall elect fifteen delegates-at-large."*
- *"The delegates so elected shall convene at the capitol on the first Tuesday of April next ensuing after their election..." [April 2019]*
- *"Any proposed constitution or constitutional amendment which shall have been adopted by such convention, shall be submitted to a vote of the electors of the state, at an election which shall be held not less than six weeks after the adjournment of such convention."*

***IF the changes are approved by the voters...*** 

*"Upon approval of such constitution or constitutional amendments...such constitution or constitutional amendment, shall go into effect on the first day of January next after such approval."*
