2015 Empire Plan Flexible Formulary Drug List: New Excluded Medications for 2015

2015 Empire Plan Flexible Formulary Drug List means a Preferred Drug List in which Brand Drugs may be assigned to different copayment levels based on value and clinical judgment. In some cases, drugs may be excluded from coverage if a therapeutic alternative or over-the-counter drug is available.

Access to one or more drugs in select therapeutic categories may be restricted (not covered) if the drug(s) has no clinical advantage over other generic and brand name medications in the same therapeutic class. Drugs considered to have no clinical advantage that may be excluded include any products that:

- (1) contain an active ingredient available in and therapeutically equivalent to another drug covered in the class:
- (2) contain an active ingredient which is a modified version of and therapeutically equivalent to another covered Prescription Drug Product;
- (3) are available in over-the-counter form or comprised of components that are available in over-the-counter form or equivalent.
