## Nominating Procedures

- ◆ All UUP members are eligible to submit nominations, but each member is limited to one nomination per year.
- ◆ Each nomination shall be in writing and shall specify the reasons why the person, agency or group is being nominated as a Friend of UUP.
- ◆ Each nomination shall be endorsed by the signatures of no less than three other UUP members or a UUP committee. All nomination and endorsing documents must include the addresses and phone numbers of their authors and must be submitted with the nomination prior to the deadline.
